Purpose of the Position

To plan, deliver and evaluate person-centred Occupational Therapy services for adult clients that deliver choice and control to NDIS and other participants and meet their clinical goals.

Tasks and Responsibilities

- Working in a culturally diverse environment, provide contemporary, evidence-based Occupational Therapy services, including assessment, individualised treatment planning and evaluation for adolescents and adults presenting with a range of conditions, syndromes, and mental health concerns.
- Support with transition and ongoing treatment planning for clients with disability discharged from hospital into medium term accommodation.
- Provide independent, specialist and clinical input into treatment planning, development, and delivery of core business.
- Ensure billable Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) are met each month.
- Maintain professional internal and external stakeholder communication.
- Contribute to the development of individual and group programs within Carpentaria Therapy Services.
- Ability to implement WHS, Risk Management and Quality assurance requirements.
- Attendance and contributions to team and organisational meetings.
- Adherence to Australian Health Practitioners Registration Authority (AHPRA) and Carpentaria policies and procedures.

- Relevant experience working as an Occupational Therapist or graduate experience with having completed a relevant placement

- Commitment to working with people with and supporting people with a disability
