#### SPEECH PATHOLOGIST - THERAPY SERVICES

## Purpose of the Position

To deliver speech pathology services utilising a person-centred approach that promotes choice and control to participants in relation to their NDIS goals.

## Tasks and Responsibilities

- Working in a culturally diverse environment, provide a contemporary, evidence-based speech
  pathology service, including assessment, treatment planning and evaluation, for people presenting
  with a wide range of conditions and syndromes.
- Work collaboratively with families/caregivers to assess, plan, implement and review targeted and meaningful developmental therapy.
- Select, develop, and tailor augmentative and alternative communication systems, programs and resources for participants with communication needs based upon speech pathology assessments.
- Maintain internal and external stakeholder communication.
- Lead and contribute to the development of individual and group programs within Carpentaria Therapy Service areas.
- Attendance and contribution to team and organisational meetings, including the provision of inservices and quality and service development activities.
- Ability to implement WHS, Risk Management and Quality assurance requirements.
- Ensure billable Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) are met.

#### **Essential Criteria**

- Undergraduate or post graduate gualification in Speech Pathology.
- Current membership with Speech Pathology Australia (or eligible for membership).
- Minimum 2 years of clinical experience with a paediatric and/or adult caseload.
- Demonstrated clinical competency and experience in conducting assessments and writing high quality individualised assessment and program reports.
- Strong commitment to supporting clients to achieve their goals working in a person/family centred
  practice model
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills demonstrated by the ability to interact and negotiate with a wide range of people.
- Experience working with clients and families from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.
- Current Ochre Card, Criminal History Check, NDIS Worker Screening Clearance, NDIS Worker Orientation, First Aid & CPR Certificate and NT Driver Licence.

### **Preferred Criteria**

- Knowledge of formal and informal assessment tools, AAC prescription and implementation and intervention options
- Experience with trailing and prescribing AAC devices and software
- Experience in assessment and dysphagia management
- Interest in providing clinical supervision and mentoring to junior clinicians
- Experience working in disability sector and working with clients with cognitive impairment
