Purpose of the Position

To plan, deliver and evaluate person-centred counselling and psychological therapeutic interventions to participants who are receiving disability supports under the NDIS.

Tasks and Responsibilities

- Working in a culturally diverse environment, provide contemporary, evidence-based Psychology services, including assessment, individualised treatment planning and evaluation for participants presenting with a range of conditions, syndromes, and mental health concerns
- Deliver Multidisciplinary Assessment (MDA) clinics in collaboration with other Allied Health Practitioners to assess functional impact of conditions on the participant's daily life and provide recommendations
- Work collaboratively with clients, families and guardians, to assess, plan, implement and review targeted and meaningful developmental therapy
- Provide education to family members, educators, and support staff regarding ways to support participants and appropriate responses to different behaviours
- Provide complete documentation and records of assessments and treatments according to Carpentaria policies
- Utilise appropriate standardised assessment tools for the purposes of service intake/clinical triage, goal evaluation, and monitoring of growth/development over time
- Provide independent, specialist and clinical input into treatment planning, development, and delivery of core business
- Participate in and contribute to all meetings and identified training; showing initiative and highlighting opportunities for change and improvements in service delivery
- Ensure billable Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) are met
- Adherence to Australian Health Practitioners Registration Authority (AHPRA) and Carpentaria policies and procedures

Essential Criteria

- Undergraduate (or postgraduate) qualification in Psychology
- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioners Regulation Agency (AHPRA) and Professional Indemnity Insurance
- Experience working as a Psychologist, with the ability to demonstrate competency within the primary responsibilities outlined above
- High-level interpersonal skills with a strong person-centred focus and the ability to build and maintain effective relationships with stakeholders, including liaison, engagement and negotiation skills
- High level written communication skills, with the ability to complete comprehensive and accurate case notes and reports
- Ability to work independently, as well as part of a multi-disciplinary team, and demonstrate ownership and progress of workload unsupervised
