- Support with transition and ongoing treatment planning for clients with disability discharged from hospital into medium term accommodation.
- Provide independent, specialist and clinical input into treatment planning, development, and delivery of core business
- Ensure billable Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) are met each month
- Maintain professional internal and external stakeholder communication
- Contribute to the development of individual and group programs within Carpentaria Therapy Services
