Tasks and Responsibilities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Working in a culturally diverse environment, provide contemporary, evidence-based Psychology services, including assessment, individualised treatment planning and evaluation for children and adolescents presenting with a range of conditions, syndromes, and mental health concerns Deliver Multidisciplinary Assessment (MDA) clinics in collaboration with other Allied Health Practitioners to assess functional impact of conditions on the young person's daily life and provide recommendations Educate family members, carers, and educators on what they can do to support young people and or how to respond to certain behaviours Provide complete documentation and records of assessments and treatments according to Carpentaria policies Utilise appropriate standardised assessment tools for the purposes of service intake/clinical triage, goal evaluation, and monitoring of growth/development over time Maintain professional internal and external stakeholder communication Work collaboratively with client's families and/or other relevant professionals and support networks Work collaboratively within Carpentaria's Multidisciplinary Team Timely report and letter writing skills
